Announcements and opening prayer



Connect: an opportunity for people to immediately interact and connect with each other; icebreaker/attention getters. **Icebreaker:** Can you think of a time when you planned something exciting, something great, and it fell through? What usually happens when our excitement and plans are crushed?

Question: Do great leaders ever make mistakes? Why?

The Bottom Line: A lack of holiness among God's people withholds His blessings!

Transition: Today we are going to look at how easily it can happen to the greatest of godly leaders. If it can happen to incredibly spiritually gifted people, then we need to realize that no one is exempt. That is the beauty of the church. When we are all that Jesus created us to be, we are a community who loves each other so deeply we help one another through those times.

Read Joshua 7:1-9

1. What happened to the 3,000 men who went up to take Ai?
2. Were the spies to blame for underestimating the people of Ai?

It is estimated that Israel had about 600,000 soldiers. However, they had already seen God's promise at Jericho. The Lord gave them victory. The Lord was in this conquest for the long haul. It was His idea. They bore no blame for their decision, but someone did.

3. What does Joshua do when he sees that God has not given them victory?
