Announcements and opening prayer



Connect: an opportunity for people to immediately interact and connect with each other; icebreaker/attention getters. **Icebreaker:** If God somehow told you through your leaders that He was about to do something great, how would you get ready that day?

Question: God has a plan for you and me to make disciples of all ethnic groups, to cover the earth with His truth. His plan is for us to go forth and take this land for His glory. How do you prepare for that mission that Jesus plainly stated?

The Bottom Line: God can overpower the greatest odds for His faithful!

LESSON PLAN



Denotes "Apply"

Background: *In preparing to take the land, God has the people restore the covenant of circumcision that had been neglected for the last 40 years. Only the children who came out of Egypt had been circumcised according to the Law. No male could participate in the Passover unless they were circumcised according to Exodus 12:48-49, so the time had come to reestablish God's covenant with those. Now that they have this covenant sign, the Passover can take its rightful place among the people.*

2. Why do you think it was important to God that all the men born in the desert during the 40 years of wandering were circumcised?

In archaeological data we find that Jericho was a city of great prominence and wealth. Excavations show they had massive defenses. The dig showed there was an earthen embankment stabilized by a 15' stone wall. Atop that was a free standing mud brick wall another 6' thick and 18-24' high. Jericho's mud walls crumpled in a heap at the base of the retaining wall. Archaeologists suggest that an earthquake took place and that the fallen bricks formed a ramp by which the Israelites climbed the retaining wall. There was a 3' high layer of ash that confirms the fires and utter destruction.

- What do you think God is leading us forward to accomplish for His Glory?
