***Announcements, encouragement to invite people and opening prayer.**



Connect: an opportunity for people to immediately interact and connect with each other; icebreaker/attention getters. **Icebreaker:** If someone asked you to give some examples of spiritual darkness in the world, what would you say?

Transition: There are many kinds of darkness that apart from Christ, we do not see or understand as being dark.

Bottom Line: The dominion or ruling force of this world is darkness. Walking with Jesus frees us from the dangers of this dark world. It opens our eyes by His Word and Spirit.

LESSON PLAN

Question: Who were your favorite TV or comic book heroes as a child?

Read Colossians 2:1

1. Paul has not met these Christians, yet what is he doing for them and for the Christians at Laodicea?

Question: What are some people you hurt for that you have never met? What are some countries you know of where it is dangerous to live out the Christian faith?

Read Colossians 1:1-8

2. What was the focus of Paul and Timothy's prayers for these Christians at Colossae?

Question: Have you heard of a church that is known for, has a reputation for loving others and living out their faith in a radical way? Who? Why do you think there are not more churches like the Colossian Church?

Question: What are you personally doing to pass on the grace of God?

Read Colossians 1:9-14

5. What can we learn about prayer from Paul and Timothy’s example?

6. What was the purpose of Paul and Timothy’s prayers for them?

- e. That they would be strengthened with all according to Jesus’ glorious might.
- f. That they would have great endurance and and joy.
