3. Read 1 Peter 1:22-25. What is the perishable seed that God refers to and what is the imperishable seed?

4. Read 1 Peter 2:1-2:3. If we have been born again what does God expect of us?

Encounter Life

1. How do you prepare mind to function in this world in a way that pleases Christ?

2. Do you really have a reverent fear of the Lord? If so, how does that affect your choices?

3. God says that once we have been born again, we should love each other deeply from the heart. How would you grade yourself on this area of your faith? A (excellent) to F (failing)?
