4. Have you ever known someone who was that dishonest with their boss?

5. Read Luke 16:8-15. Why would the master commend or compliment the manager for his dishonesty?

6. How can people of the light, meaning Christians, lack shrewdness in dealing with other people?

7. What does God have to say about how we use our worldly wealth?

8. How do people try to serve two masters, meaning God and stuff?

9. What do you think Jesus is trying to tell you through this study?
