4. Read Proverbs 11:16. What do you think God means by a ‘kind-hearted woman.’

5. What difference does a kind heart make within a single woman?

6. Read Proverbs 11:22. Describe the idea God is painting with this picture.

7. Read Proverbs 31:30. What does Solomon tell us makes a woman worthy of praise in the eyes of God and man?

8. What do you believe keeps you from fearing the Lord as greatly as you should?
