“Share Your Peace” – Isaiah 2:1-4 & 4:2-6

Icebreaker: You are running for Miss America. You just gave the answer, “I just want the world to have peace.” Now you are asked to explain what you mean by peace. What is your answer?

They world’s idea of peace and God’s often differ significantly. Let’s see what God has said about understanding peace and sharing your peace.

An Encounter with the Word of God

1. Read Isaiah 2:1-2. We are living in the last days. What does God say will be significant about this time period?

2. Describe your life in Christ. How do you stream, flow up to Jesus daily?

3. Read Isaiah 2:3-4. What is the purpose of going up to the mountain of the Lord?

4. Notice that we are to approach God for the purpose of learning which equips us to walk in His “paths.” Also notice that “paths” is plural. What are some of the paths of God He calls us to learn and apply?

5. Read Isaiah 4:2-6. The word “Branch” meant to grow and sprout. When it was capitalized it meant it was a title for the Messiah. How is Jesus, the Branch, described?

6. Pride is not always a bad thing. Pride in what is healthy, being proud of someone you love is actually wise. How is Jesus your pride?

7. What will the Lord create over Mt. Zion?

8. How was God your shelter and your refuge today?
