“Sharing When No One Wants to Listen” – Isaiah 6

Icebreaker: What is one thing that really bothers or annoys you?

Let's take a good long honest look at our lives and see what it is that keeps us from surrendering our lives to being God's tools for change.

An Encounter with the Word of God

1. Read Isaiah 6:1-4. What were the seraphs, the angels around the throne of God, calling to one another?

2. What could you do to better understand the concept of God's holiness?

3. How much time per week do you spend declaring God's holiness? Do you shake the foundations of Heaven with your praise? Why or why not?

4. Read Isaiah 6:5-7. Why did Isaiah suddenly begin saying woe is me, which meant something like, “Man am I in trouble!”

5. God gave us an image of the coal from the altar of God being put to Isaiah's lips by an angel to cleanse them. What could this image be telling you and me today?

6. Read Isaiah 6:8-13. Why would God ask whom He should send rather than just saying, “Isaiah, you gotta go for Me!”

7. God tells Isaiah up front that people are not going to listen to Him, yet He wants him to go anyway. What does this tell you about Isaiah and what does it tell you about God?

8. How are you like Isaiah? How are you different? What could you do to become more like this incredible servant of God?
